We are still living with COVID-19. We continue to work with the CDC, CMS (Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services) and the SD Department of Health. We strongly encourage all residents and families to make sure they are receiving boosters.


When we do have positive cases, we are seeing those residents who are up to date are having no to mild symptoms. Those who are not up to date are seeing a few more symptoms. If you would like to get your resident up to date on his or her COVID-19 vaccines or have questions about the COVID-19 boosters, please contact Stephanie Herman, Infection Control Preventionist, or visit with your resident's nurse.

We have updated our visitation policy. Starting March 1, we will be allowing one family member to accompany their resident to an activity, a church service or sit with them in the dining room. The visitor must be masked during these times. Family will still not be able to eat in the dining room with residents; however, if you would like to bring in food you can eat with your family member in their room or one of the lounges, but we ask that you contact the Activities department so we can reserve the space and we do not double up on events. Also, if you are planning a party (birthday, anniversary, etc.) please contact Activities to arrange this. We still ask at this time to not sit in A wing lounge (by the South Station) due to the fact that we currently have a lot of resident who utilize this lounge.

We are excited our activity room remodel is almost complete. We have focused on updating the kitchen area so we can continue to do baking projects with our residents. It has also allowed us to bring in a coffee bar for the residents and our staff. We now offer coffee and iced coffee, regular and decaffeinated. Plus, we have multiple flavored syrups and creamers to add to their coffee. The residents were able to enjoy a taste testing to sample all of the new syrups and creamers.

Our next project will be to start on our Bethesda Pub. This will be an area next to the dining room which allows residents to have a place to meet and gather before meals. We have some exciting ideas that we will be sharing as we get closer to it's opening.

My Journey to Bethesda vera St. Luke's Hospital on As my time with physical the

I had my right hip replaced at Avera St. Luke's Hospital on November 22, 2022. The procedure was more complicated because I broke my right femur 10 years ago playing pickleball in Florida. The surgeon placed rods and pins in that leg to correct the fracture. New bone growth had covered the rods. Rods, pins, and bones needed to be removed prior to being able to place the new hip, which caused extensive damage to my leg. I spent 10 days in the hospital with very limited use of that leg, which required physical therapy follow-up for an extended period of time. I was moved to Bethesda Home of Aberdeen on December 4 for an extended temporary stay for further physical therapy. At this time I was unable to do much with my right leg, and my mobility was provided by a wheelchair and a walker. I spent 20 days at Bethesda Home of Aberdeen.

I was cared for by a wonderful staff of people, from the administrative section to all the various care providers. All providers treated me with kindness, respect, and cheerfulness. These peoples' skills that they displayed made me feel important to their care and made the days more bright. They are all extremely busy but found time to stop in to chat and see if there was anything I needed.

As my time with physical therapy progressed, I became much more able to use my right leg so that a wheelchair was not necessary, and I used just my walker. Under the guidance of the physical therapists, my usage of my right leg progressed smoothly. As the staff noticed that I was moving more quickly, they would ask if I was entering a racing contest.

Going to the dining room for our meals proved to be my main social outing with the other residents. We shared a lot of stories and had a lot of laughs. As busy as this staff was, they took good care of us and provided us with very good meals while creating an enjoyable atmosphere.

If in life others need the services of a skilled nursing facility, either temporarily or resident status, you will wish to be placed in a facility in which you will be treated competently, warmly, cheerfully, and respectfully as I was treated at Bethesda.

To all the staff at Bethesda, you are all wonderful caregivers and I sincerely thank you!
