Bethesda Aberdeen serves as Aberdeen's Champion Organization and fiscal sponsor for this DFA membership.


Pictured is Governor Kristi Noem with the Aberdeen DFA contingent as she signed a proclamation declaring it Dementia Friendly America day in South Dakota.

(C.D.S.) Credentials through HealthCare Interactive.

HealthCare Interactive is an organization committed to improving dementia care for people living with Alzheimer's disease and other progressive dementias. They are the only online dementia care training recognized by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

CARES Dementia Certification tests a user's dementia understanding and dementia care knowledge from the Alzheimer's Association Dementia Care Practice Recommendations and published CARES research studies.

Pionk is the first person in South Dakota to earn the C.D.S credential.

Pionk, who has an AS degree in Health Information Management and worked in healthcare for 15 years, has been the Director of the Adult Day Health Center at Bethesda since 2018.

BETHESDA HOME EARNS 5-STAR QUALITY RANKING ONCE AGAIN

Bethesda Home of Aberdeen was recently awarded another 5-Star Quality Rating by the United States government. Nursing Home Compare (NHC) provides quality ratings for each of the nation's 15,000 Medicare and/or Medicaid-certified skilled nursing home facilities.

The quality rating system gives each nursing home a rating between 1 and 5 stars. Nursing homes with 5 stars, like Bethesda Home of Aberdeen, are considered to have "much above average" quality.

Nursing Home Compare is a user-friendly web tool found at www.medicare.gov/nursinghomecompare that provides information on how well Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes provide care to their residents.



"This rating system assists families in their decision-making as they research and seek care options for loved ones," stated Scott Eisenbeisz, CEO/Administrator.

The overall goal of the ranking system is to determine how well a nursing home is caring for residents' physical and clinical needs.

Eisenbeisz gave credit to his staff, "Earning another 5-Star Quality Rating is a true validation of the standard of care our dedicated staff members strive to provide to our residents each and every day."

Innovative Services!

Bethesda Home opened its doors nearly 50 years ago on December 26, 1969, as a skilled nursing care facility on a 22-acre campus in Aberdeen. Our growth is thanks to the vision and dedicated support by many.

Our Growing Services:

In 1981, the Bethesda Sharing Center opened to provide child care to employees; later expanded to the community including daycare and preschool.

In 1985, a vision for a continuum of care was recognized and Bethesda Parkside Apartments were established. (Renamed Parkside Retirement Community at a later date.)

In 1997, Bethesda Towne Square was opened to provide assisted living services to meet the need for services be-tween our nursing facilities and apartments.

In 2001, Bethesda Home completed a renovation to provide private rooms for all residents. In 2008, Bethesda In-Home Community Services were added to provide care for people in their home environment.

The K.O. Lee Adult Day Health Center opened in November 2014 and provides customized care to stay at home longer.

BETHESDA ONE CALL

Bethesda has teamed up with One Call Now to help improve our communications with Family, Tenants, and Employees. Bethesda One Call will allow communication to happen in real time for reminders, events, changes in events, or emergencies. The system will allow text, calls, or emails; however, Bethesda has chosen to use the phone call option at this time. Bethesda feels that phone will be the quickest way to communicate as we can send messages to either a cell phone or a land line phone.

Who is on the Call List?

- contacts. Residents will not receive any calls.
- Bethesda Towne Square: Up to three family member/ Emergency or urgent communications could occur contacts. Residents will not receive any calls.
- Parkside: Tenants (unless Tenant has a responsible party). If tenant would like to add two additional family members/contacts, the tenant can contact the business office.

How does it work?

We have two options:

- Recording a live voice
- Type to speak (automated voice) Most likely it will be the automated voice that you will be hearing in the message.

How do I know it is from Bethesda?

- You will receive a call from the following number: Please remember if you change phone numbers or 1-877-698-3261 (We suggest you add this number to your contacts in your phone as Bethesda One Call)
- We will always identify who the message is from and that we represent Bethesda


What time of the day will I receive calls?

- Bethesda Home: Up to three family member/ All routine communications will occur M-F between 8 am and 5 pm
 - 24 hours a day

Can I opt out of getting calls?

- Bethesda Home and Bethesda Towne Square
 - ~ Yes, if you do not want to receive calls as a family member you can contact the business office during normal hours and your name can be removed. We will require at least one family member on the call list. If you need to add or delete contacts, please call the business office during normal hours.
- Parkside
 - ~ No, we will require tenants to be on the list
